



Summer Camp – Packing List

6/25/2022 – 7/3/2022 @ Woodruff Scout Camp in Blairsville, Georgia

Sunrise 6:24 am, Sunset 8:53 pm

Daily high average 87°F, Daily low average 70°F

Expect light to heavy rains.

Consider

- ✓ Mark clothes and trunk with name and troop #.
- ✓ Divide your clothing into 2 gallon plastic bags for each day of the week.
- ✓ Wear a Scouting Type T-Shirt.
- ✓ Wear convertible pants that can be unzipped and turned into shorts.
- ✓ Wear a hat, and comfortable shoes and socks. No sandals. Suggest you wear long socks.

You will have your day pack and a trunk with your gear. Keep your Day Bag with you at all times. When you travel to and from camp you should have your Day Bag with you. Don't bring your Day Bag to be hauled in the trailer.

Day bag

- Water Bottle
- Bug spray
- High SPF Sunblock
- Lip Balm
- Multi-tool *(if you have earned you right to carry it)*
- Head lamp or flashlight *(with fresh batteries)*
- Personal First Aid
- Paper and Pencil
- Compass & Whistle
- Watch
- Rain Jacket or Poncho
- Duct Tape
- Nylon Rope

Inside your trunk

- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping mat *(Optional. At camp you will be housed in 9' x 7' BSA tent on permanent wood platform with a folding cot)*
- Official Troop 109 Tent *(For one night sleepover at Robins AFB campground on traveling to and from camp)*

- Folding Camp Chair *(Optional)*
- Small Electric Fan *(Optional)*
- Small Pillow *(Optional)*
- 1 full outfit per day of camp *(individually Ziploc)*
 - Activity T-Shirt *(If you do not have enough Scouting t-shirts, then any appropriate t-shirt (nothing suggestive, alcohol-related, etc.).*
 - Underwear
 - Bottoms
 - Socks
- 1 Field uniform *(“Class A” Shirt, Pants, and Belt)*
- Extra Long Sleeve Shirts
- Light Sweater/Jacket
- Tennis shoes
- Hiking boots
- Shower Shoes *(Crocs-Yes. Sandals-No)*
- Water Shoes
- Swimming trunks *(Swimwear that is suited for active water sports such as swim trunks or board shorts. Cover ups and t-shirts are expected to be worn outside of the swim area)*
- Medium Weight Pajamas
- Wool Cap - if it gets cold
- One or two towels, quick drying is ideal
- Personal bathing items: Soap, Toothbrush, Gold Bond, Deodorant, Etc
- Hat

Don't Forget

- Spending Money (\$5 a day)
- Medications *(To give to Medical Officer)*
- Merit Badge pamphlets & Scout Handbook
- Electronics are allowed on the bus to and from camp, bring your own chargers.

The Do Not Brings

- ✗ No Open Toe Sandals!
- ✗ No Blue Jeans!
- ✗ No BIG knives
