

Mr. C's Gear List for North Georgia Summer Camps

Appalachian Mt Terrain. Summer Temps 84 – 55 F. Light to Heavy rain expected every day.

Consider

Mark clothes with name and troop #.

For new scouts divide your clothing into 1 gallon plastic bags for each day of the week.

Clothing (from Head to toe)

1 Scout uniform (Shirt, Pants, and Belt)
5 Short Sleeve T-shirts (Class B or Similar)
2 Long Sleeve Shirts
6 underwear
3 Short Pants (Pockets)
1 Long Pants (Not Blue Jeans)
Wind Breaker / Rain Jacket
Rain Pants
Light Sweater
6 Normal socks
2 Thick Wool Socks
2 Scout Socks
Tennis shoes
Hiking boots
Shower Shoes (Cros-Yes. Sandals-No)
Swimming trunks
Medium Weight Pajamas

Wear or Carry These Always

Hat (Name and Troop # on inside)
Sunglasses (with a strap)
Watch
Pocketknife / Leather Man (If you have earned the right to carry it)
Compass
Whistle

Toiletries (A Scout is Clean)

Toothbrush / Paste
Bath towel / Wash Cloth
Soap / Shampoo
Comb / Brush
Beach Towel
Medications (To give to Medical Officer)

For older scouts:

Underarm Deodorant
Gold Bond (Travel Size)

Tent Gear

Medium Weight Sleeping bag
Small Electric Tent Fan (Optional)
Small Pillow (Optional)

Camp Gear (Be Prepared)

A Day Pack carrying the following:
Water Bottle (name and Troop # on it)
Personal First Aid Kit (Band Aids, etc)
Lip balm
Insect repellent
Sunblock
Flashlight with fresh batteries
Duct Tape (10 feet)
¼ Nylon Rope (10 feet)
Clothes pens
Extra Batteries (for fan and flashlight)
